

SOUND FACTS MOST NOMINATIONS AND AWARDS

[Updated thru 96th Awards (3/24)]

NOTE: This document combines statistics for all sound categories. From the 1929/30 Awards through the 1968 Awards, the Sound award was given to the studio sound department and not to specific individual(s). Beginning with the 1969 Awards, the Sound award was given to the person(s) who actually recorded the sound. Sound Editing became its own category at the 1963 (36th) Awards (prior to that year audible effects were honored along with photographic effects as part of the Special Effects category - see separate document). Special Achievement (Sound Effects Editing) Awards count as both a nomination and award.
